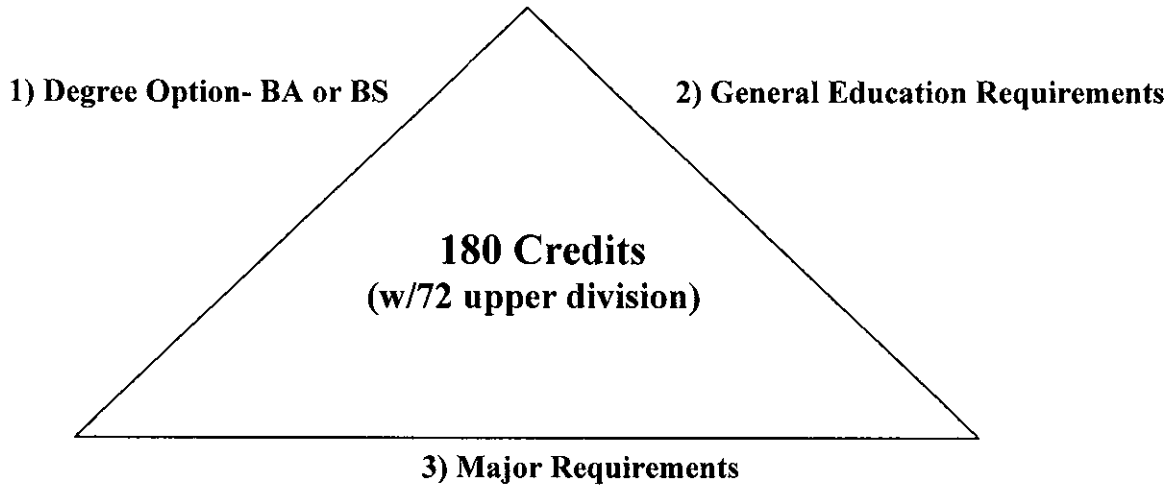

PSU Graduation Requirements



1) Degree Options: SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS FOR B.A. *or* B.S. DEGREE

B.A. Degree 12 credit hours A&L w/minimum of 4 credits in fine & performing arts + 12 credits in the science and/or social science area w/minimum of 4 credits in the science area + 4 credits in foreign language numbered 203 or higher (28 credit hours total)

OR

B.S. Degree 12 credit hours A&L and/or Social Science + 4 credit hours math/stat + 12 credit hours Science, 8 of which must have lab or field work (28 credit hours total)

2) GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS: UNIVERSITY STUDIES

Freshman Inquiry - 15 credits

- University Studies Freshman Inquiry is not required of students who transfer to PSU with at least 30 credits.
- Students who transfer to PSU with 30-44 quarter credits are required to complete the Transfer Transition and will begin University Studies with Sophomore Inquiry.

Sophomore Inquiry - 12 credits

- If you transfer with 45-59 credits you need to take 3 Sophomore Inquiries.
- If you transfer with 60-74 credits you need to take 2 Sophomore Inquiries.
- If you transfer with 75-89 credits you need to take 1 Sophomore Inquiry.

Upper Division Cluster - 12 credits

- Students transferring to PSU with 90 or more credit hours begin University Studies with Upper Division Cluster
- Cluster courses must be taken outside of the major department. This includes courses that might be cross-listed elsewhere with the major prefix.

Senior Capstone (Community Based Learning Project) - 6 credits
