



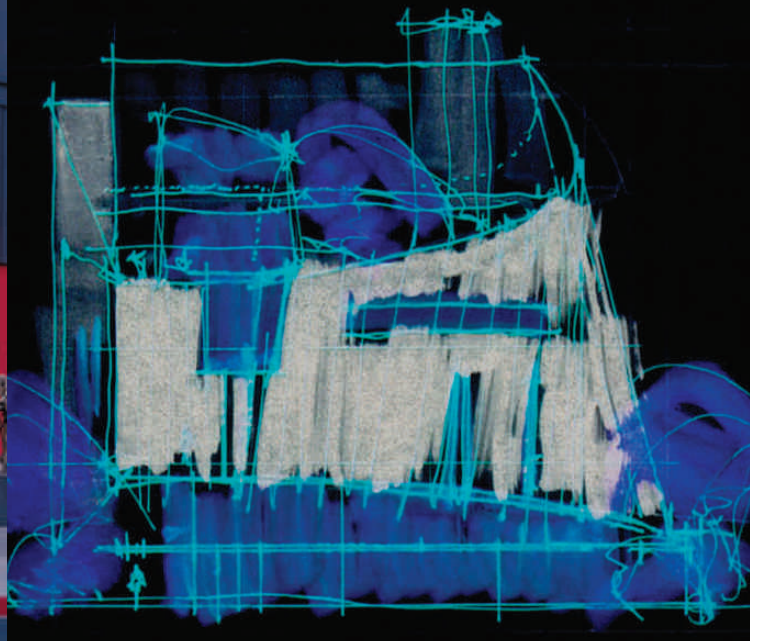

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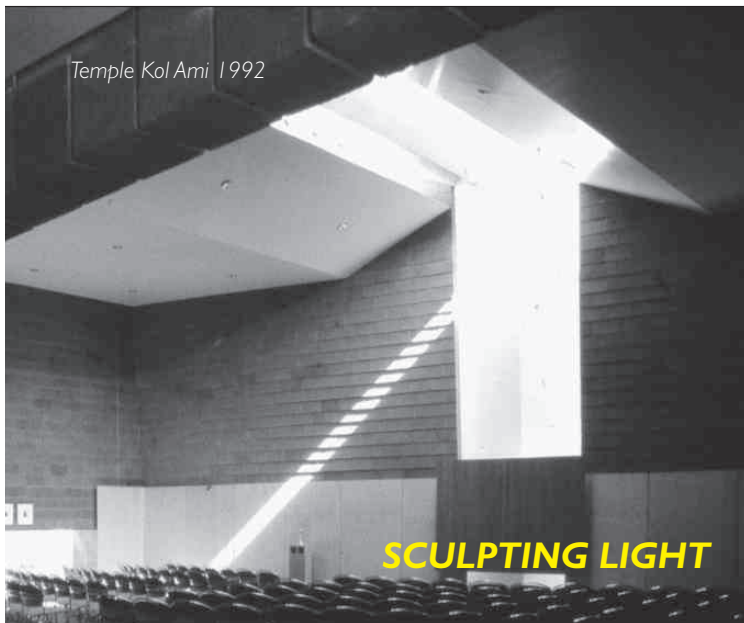

## SCULPTING LIGHT

With the city of Portland as his laboratory and the recent sustainable renovation of Shattuck Hall as the location of his studio, the Department of Architecture at Portland State University is pleased to announce the appointment of the internationally respected architect, urban designer, thinker, and mentor, Will Bruder, as the inaugural Distinguished Visiting Professor in Urban Architecture.

Bruder's insight, imagination, and tangible generosity of spirit will bring an added, unique depth of creativity to both graduate and undergraduate pedagogy. He brings significant practice experience in the design and fabrication of materially and spatially rich architecture to design studios during the Fall and Winter quarters over the next 2 years.

Using the urban reality of Portland as the foundation, and the challenges of today as the condition, the Bruder PSU studios will grapple with the basic and the complex, the old and the new, the real and the virtual, the detail and the 'big idea'. Students' minds, hearts and hands will be empowered to understand and engage in making an architecture and urbanism both timely and timeless, one rooted to place yet grappling with the difficult questions of contemporary human experience.

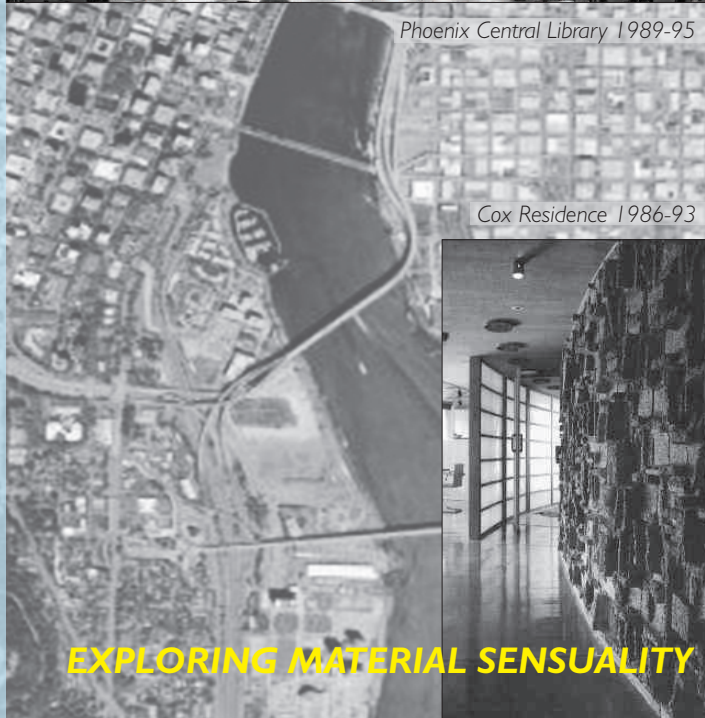
