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### FIRST YEAR REQUIRED COURSES **20 CREDITS**

Choose two (2) of the following Studio Foundation courses equaling 8 credit hours:

ART 182 Idea & Form (4) 8 credits  
ART 115 Two-Dimensional Design (4)  
ART 117 Three-Dimensional Design (4)  
ART 119 Digital/Time Design (4)  
ART 131 Introduction to Drawing I (4)

Complete the following Art History sequence for 12 credit hours:

ArH 204, 205, 206 History of Western Art (4, 4, 4) 12 credits

\*ArH 208 Intro to Asian Art (4).

\*For students whose focus is Asian Studies, ArH 208 can be taken instead of ArH 204 **or** 205 **or** 206. This only applies to Art History or Art History/Studio majors.

### SECOND YEAR REQUIRED COURSES **12 CREDITS**

ART 203 Meaning & Making **or** 4 credits  
ART 230 Drawing Concepts I (Choose just one (1) of these two courses for 4 credits)  
\*\* Two (2) 200-level studio ART courses (4, 4) 8 credits

\*\* Both within one of the following focus areas: Drawing and Painting, Photography, Printmaking, Sculpture, Social Art Practices or Time Arts.

**Important:** When deliberating which studio courses to take, please factor in prerequisites. You will not be able to register for **Upper-Division (UD)** courses without having taken the corresponding **Lower Division** requirements (**LD**). Please review course descriptions in the PSU Bulletin for prerequisites. **LD** courses are numbered 100-200. **UD** courses are numbered 300-400.

### THIRD AND FOURTH YEAR ART HISTORY CONCENTRATION **36 CREDITS**

ART 330 Critical Theories in Art I 4 credits  
\*\*\* Two (2) 300-level studio ART courses (4, 4) 8 credits

\*\*\* Both within the same focus area selected above: Drawing and Painting, Photography, Printmaking, Sculpture, Social Art Practices or Time Arts.

Select six (6) 300-and/or 400-level Upper-Division Art History courses 24 credits
