The Sunnyside Swap and Spring Clean Up is coming up to kick off this year's Earth Day Week! Reduce, reuse, and recycle your stuff at the Saint Stephens Catholic Church gym and parking lot.

Friday, April 15th – Sunday, April 17th 2011.

Exchange clean, working, useful items you don't want for ones that you do. Swap clothes, furniture, appliances, kitchenware, books, toys, and tools with your neighbors. Clean up your yard and house by dropping off bulky waste and recyclables in designated drop boxes.

Volunteers with customer service and rummage/retail experience skills needed. These are volunteer-run events and each day will be very hands-on and focused on working with people.

Volunteer on FRIDAY: set up the event and accept goods dropped off ahead of time. (6:00pm - 9:00pm)

Volunteer on SATURDAY: accept and display goods for the swap. Meet, greet and explain the swap event. Sort goods and assist swappers! (Three shifts: 8:00am - 11:00am; 10:30am - 1:30pm; 1:00pm - 4:00pm)

Volunteer on SUNDAY: categorize and price goods for sale, assist customers, help to clean up after the event. Rummage sale goes from 10-1 with funds donated back to the sponsoring agencies. (Sunday shifts: 9:30am - 11:30am; 11:30 am - 2:00pm; 9:00am - 2:00pm)
