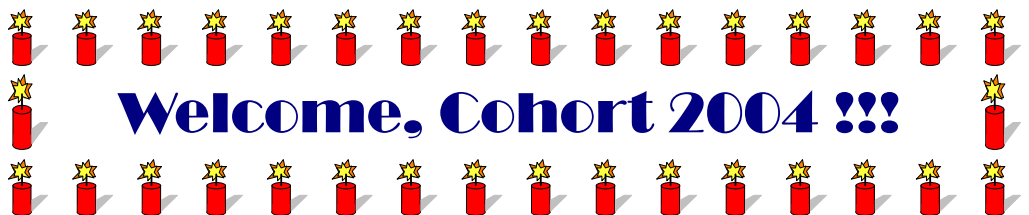
### *A Few Words from New CSJ Faculty Advisor ~ Hanoch Livneh*

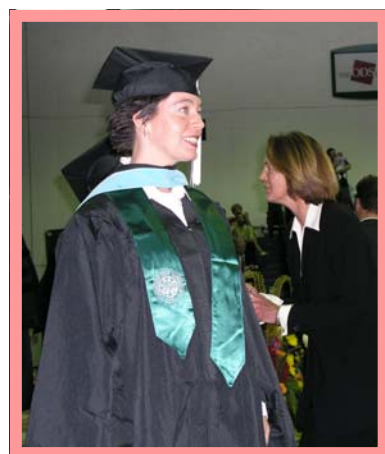

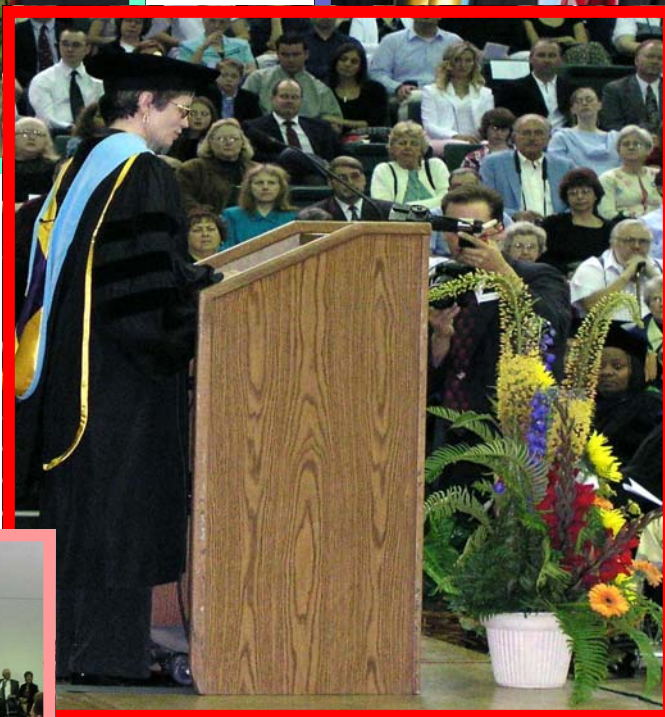

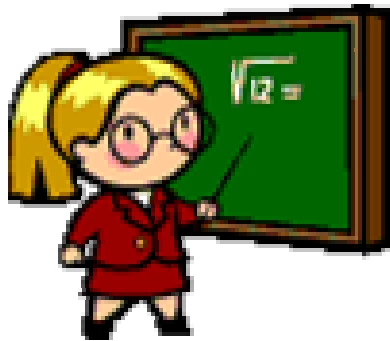

As an internship site, the Wellness Project, located in Vancouver, WA is a site that will provide a wide range of clients and excellent supervision. This clinic provides free mental health care to those not covered by a health plan in Washington.

Many working families have employment that does not provide them with adequate health care access which is the population that this projects seeks to assist. As of September of 2004, the clinic will be moving from their current location at Mental

Health Northwest to new sight in the downtown area of Vancouver. There is a waiting list of up to 30 days however, with additional interns coming from Lewis and Clark College, George Fox College and Portland State Univer-

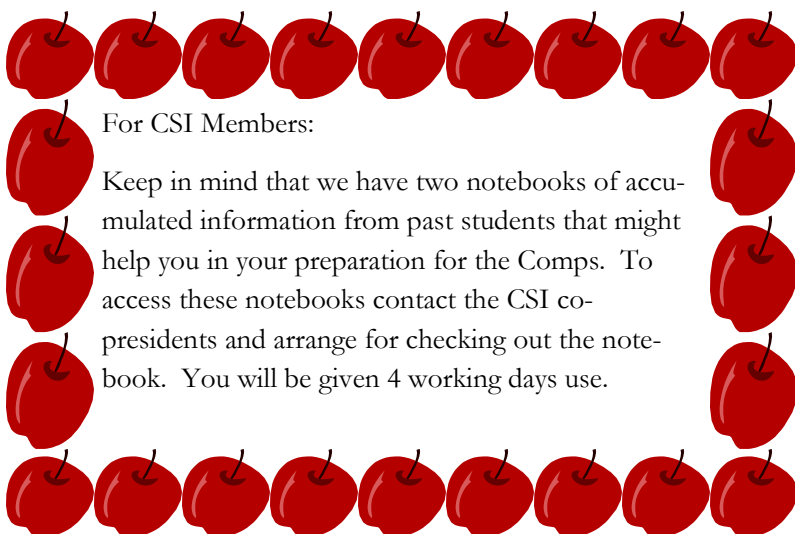
