New Classes Developed

Seminar I: Continuing School Counselor Licensure - The focus of this course was collaboration; school counselor's collaboration with colleagues, staff, parents, and the public to enhance students' performance. The time was also spent orienting students to the scope of the Continuing Licensure Program.

Seminar II: Continuing School Counselor Licensure - The second seminar's focus was to explore the legal and ethical imperatives of school counselors. Students would emerge with an advanced understanding of laws applicable to school counselors. I also clarified the requirements of the professional portfolio and consulted on student's supervision progress and experience.

Seminar III: Continuing School Counselor Licensure – The third seminar's content was aimed at providing resources to facilitate effective leadership in communication with diverse special interest organizations. Students also presented their portfolios at this seminar, sharing their growth and leadership in the field.

Practicum: Summer David Douglas High School – This class was conducted on site with 8th grade students preparing to go to the David Douglas High School. Six practicum students worked with 40 students. Each set of three practicum students worked with 20 8th graders in both large and small groups. All 40 came together for the last half hour to participate in large group challenges led by the practicum students. Interns provided individual supervision for each practicum student. I met with PSU students in different sets to facilitate cohesiveness; sometimes practicum students and interns together; sometimes my doctoral student and I would meet with them separately, etc. Individual practicum students prepared the curriculum for each day using ethical developmental guidelines, and then the group co-constructed daily plans to meet the needs of the students.
