The Robert Burns Supper Committee will host the Fourth Annual Robert Burns Supper to benefit PSU's School of Fine & Performing Arts on January 23, 2010 at the Smith Memorial Student Union - Ballroom, on the Portland State University campus. The Robert Burns Supper is a unique experience and not to be missed. It combines the rituals and pageantry of a traditional Scottish supper with the poems and writings of Scotland's most famous muse, Robert Burns. These suppers are a tradition around the world, and this year is especially great as it will take place in the newly refurbished Smith Memorial Student Union - Ballroom.

The evening begins with a no-host bar and reception accompanied by the Rose in the Heather Band. Then the fun continues, with live performances by a pipers and highland dancers. The dinner begins with the piping in of the haggis, followed by a dramatic reading of the poem Ode to a Haggis given by a native of Scotland in full clan regalia, John

Angus MacLean. This is followed by a song, "For A' That" which is guaranteed to bring tears to the eyes of any true Scot. After a door prize is awarded, the buffet is opened.

Dinner is a lovely buffet of haggis, neaps (turnips) and tatties (potatoes), a Bonnie Prince Charlie chicken entrée, and a vegetarian option. Soup, salad, vegetables and rolls round out the dinner which is followed by an incredible dessert and coffee.

After dinner there will be more songs and raffle prizes, closely followed by the presentation of the Immortal Memory of Robert Burns. Dinner concludes with humorous Toasts by the Laddies with a Reply from the Lassies.

The evening continues with a presentation from a nationally known Distillery, Highland Park, who will present very special single malt whisky for your tasting pleasure.

Please join us for a wonderful evening of haggis eating and toast making as we gather once more to celebrate the wonderful poetry and songs of the famous bard Robert Burns...with a few bagpipes thrown in for good measure!
