### Scholarship Award Information

Scholarship awards are competitive for students planning to major in brass, classical guitar, jazz, percussion, piano, strings, voice and woodwinds. Scholarships are awarded for performance and academic ability and range from \$500 to full tuition. The total scholarship amount awarded will never exceed in-state instruction fees. Scholarships do not cover fees such as the health insurance fee, building fee, incident fee, technology fee, music resource fee, applied music fee, practice room key fee, etc. Only instructional fees (tuition) are covered. By mid-May, scholarship recipients will be notified by mail of the amount and terms of their award.

### Scholarship Criteria

- 1) Admission to Portland State University and enrolled as a full time declared music major
- 2) Maintenance of minimum GPA as required by scholarship and significant progress toward a degree in music
- 3) Consistent attendance and participation in all music major courses and ensembles as specified by the student's degree requirements, the particular scholarship's acceptance requirements, and those requirements assigned by the student's advisor
- 4) Must register for the following by the second week of the term:
  - a. Performance Attendance (MUS 188, undergraduate only)
  - b. Appropriate applied music, private lessons (MUP)
  - c. Music Theory and/or Music History
  - d. Large and/or small music ensemble(s)
  - e. An undergraduate student must enroll in at least 12 credits. A graduate student must enroll in at least 9 credits.
