- In addition to the two weeks prior to fall term, Roads includes an additional one-credit seminar that meets Wednesdays from 4-4:50 during fall term. You must keep this time available when you register for fall classes.
- Move-in for residential Roads students will be on Monday, September 13th from 9am- 4pm for the Broadway and Ondine buildings (room assignments were mailed beginning July 9, 2010).
- Room & board for the additional week (for on-campus students) and lunch (for off-campus students) are included in the Roads program free of charge.
