■ All students **must** contact the PSU World Languages and Literatures faculty for all tests in the following languages: Arabic, American Sign Language, Chinese, Danish, Finnish, French, German, Ancient Greek, Modern Greek, Hebrew, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Kurdish, Latin, Norwegian, Persian, Portuguese (Brazilian/Continental), Russian, Spanish, Swahili, Swedish, Turkish and Vietnamese.

If your language is not on this list, please contact Elise Wagner in the Department of World Languages and Literatures for information as to how you may fulfill the foreign language requirement.

■ These tests are proctored by Testing Services in the Center for Student Health and Counseling (SHAC). The fee is \$75 (\$50 to BYU-FLATS, \$25 to SHAC Testing).

■ All tests are pass/fail, multiple-choice and include a listening comprehension section. There is a two-and-a-half hour time limit.

■ There is a mandatory 6-month waiting period for retaking a failed test.

3. Student is required to call SHAC, Testing Services to check on the arrival of the test two weeks from the date of ordering and make an appointment to take the test.
4. After taking the test, allow 2 weeks for the results to be received and processed in the World Languages and Literatures office. A Pass score will result in a waiver of the 2nd language requirement for the B.A.
