

### **Overall Description**

The basement has a singular corridor with multiple office spaces. The building's main stairwell, S2, is located along a single corridor C1 which leads to the upper floors. There is an egress stairwell to the outside in the eastern part of the basement.

### **Corridor Navigation**

C1 is the only corridor and connects to all public areas of the basement. To its west is room 1; to north is room 2, stairwell S2, and room 3; to its west are egress stairs to the outside; to its south are rooms 4 and 5.

### **Restrooms**

There is no restroom located in the Basement.

### **Wheelchair Accessible Entrances and Exits**

There is no wheelchair access into the basement.

### **Elevators**

There is no passenger elevator located in the building.

### **Stairs**

Stairwell S2 is located along corridor C1. This stairwell has access Floor 1.

### **Overall Description**

Floor 1 is the ground floor entry on the building. The main entry is up the stairs on the west side of the building and leads into the lobby area L101. The main entry also includes an exterior wheelchair lift providing access to the first floor. The front area is mainly office spaces along with multiple stairwells that have access to all floors. The back, east, portion of the building is occupied by a restroom and kitchen.

### **Corridor Navigation**

C101 is a short north-south corridor off of the main hallway C102. To its north are egress stairs exiting the building; to its east is the restroom 104B and stairwell S2 down to the basement; and to its south is the main hallway C102.

C102 is the main hallway running east-west through the building. To its west is lobby L101 with access to the front door; to its north is room 103, corridor C101, stairwell S102, and kitchen suite 104; to the east is an exit to the egress stairs; to the south are rooms 105 and 106.

Lobby L101, which not technically a corridor, connects multiple building resources. To its west is the front entry; to its north are stairs S101 and the main office room 101; to its east is C102; and to the west is room 107.

### **Restrooms**

Room 104B is an all-gender, single-occupancy restroom off of corridor C101.

### **Wheelchair Accessible Entrances and Exits**

Wheelchair access to the first floor is made via a wheelchair lift at the main, west, entry to the building. It serves only Floor 1.

### **Elevators**

There is no passenger elevator located within the building.

### **Stairs**

- Stairwell S101 is located on the west side of Floor 1 within lobby L101. This stairwell has access to Floors 1 through 2.
- Stairwell S102 is located along corridor C101. This stairwell has access to Floor 1 through Floor 3.
- Stairwell S2 is located directly north of stairwell S102 and leads to the basement.

### **Overall Description**

Floor 2 is not served by an elevator and is not wheelchair accessible. It is mainly office spaces with a main corridor C201 down the center of the building. This floor two all-gender restrooms and stairwells that lead to all floors.

### **Corridor Navigation**

C201 is the only corridor and connects to all areas of Floor 2. To its west is room 201; to its north is stairwell S201, room 202, stairwell S202, and vestibule V201 to the restrooms; to the east is room 204; to the south are rooms 205, 206, 207, and 208.

### **Restrooms**

Restrooms are located on the northeast side of the building. Corridor C201 leads to vestibule V201 which is where the restrooms are located. Both rooms 203A and 203B are single-occupancy, all-gender restrooms.

### **Wheelchair Accessible Entrances and Exits**

There is no wheelchair access for this floor of the Honors building.

### **Elevators**

There is no elevator located within the building.

### **Stairs**

- Stairwell S201 is located on the west side of corridor C201. This stairwell has access to Floors 1 through Floor 2.
- Stairwell S202 is located on the east side of corridor C201. This stairwell has access to Floors 1 through Floor 3.

**Overall Description**

The attic, Floor 3, is not currently accessible to the public. It serves as storage and systems space.
