This role provides critical, hands-on experience in urban planning, public administration, and environmental research.



Your Core Mission: The Metro Waste Study

Project Assistants play a critical role in the Regional Waste Plan (RWP) Multifamily Indicator Study—a crucial Metro research project focused on improving waste services for apartment and condominium residents across the greater Metro area.



Key Responsibilities (Fieldwork Focus)

- Field Data Collection: Conduct detailed site assessments across the Metro area.
- Inventory & Documentation: Observe and record details of all garbage, recycling, and glass containers (size, color, signage).
- Waste Assessment: Document the presence of organics collection (food/yard debris) and photograph any bulky waste noted.
- Stakeholder Engagement: Participate in surveys and interviews, including occasional follow-up with on-site property managers.
- Data Entry: Accurately record all required data using a CES-owned iPad, strictly following safety and data protocols.
- Logistics: Assist staff with efficient routing and scheduling for site visits.
- Need a change of pace? Assistants may also support other projects.



What We Need (Requirements)

We are looking for dedicated PSU students who are comfortable with rigorous, hands-on fieldwork!

- PSU Student Status: Must be currently enrolled in a PSU undergraduate or graduate program.
- Physical Work: Must be able to safely lift 50 lbs. and perform physical work, including lifting, bending, and loading on a regular basis.
- Comfort in the Field: Must be comfortable working in and around recycling/solid waste systems; this work can be dirty.
- Scheduling Flexibility: Ability to commit to working in-person and be available for occasional weekend and early weekday morning shifts (e.g., 6 am shifts).
- Tech Skills: High competency with MS Word, MS Excel, and Google Suite.

Preferred Qualifications

- Students with one year or more left in their studies.
- US driving license with 2 years of driving experience.
- Familiarity with solid waste systems and interest in improving sustainability.
