As you move into your new office space, there is no better time to make sure that your new home away from home is fire safe.




- * Keep storage 18" below ceilings and sprinkler heads
- * Remove trash and recycling regularly
- * Use electronic files instead of paper
- * Shelving must be secured to the wall



PLUG SOCKETS & **EXTENSION**

CORDS

- * Check for frayed or damaged cords
- * Unplug items when not in use
 - * Don't daisy chain
- * Don't use extension cords in place of permanent wiring
 - * Don't overload sockets



PERSONAL HEATERS

- * Must be UL listed
 - * Have tip-over protection
- * Have automatic temperature shutoff
- * Keep area around heater clear
- * Unplug when not in use
- * Plug directly into wall outlet

HUMAN ERROR & NEGLIGENCE

- * Open flames are prohibited
- * Use electrical equipment correctly
- * Don't leave cooking unattended (including microwave cooking)
 - * Keep fire doors closed
 - * Provide clear access to exit pathways
