### **Old Action Items and Safety Concerns**

- The FMH awnings are shedding their facades and repairs haven't been successful in the long term. Maintenance has been routinely picking up pieces that have fallen, including heavy wooden sections with nails.
  - JR to contact CPC for building and safety improvements.
    - Update: The failure of the awnings was a design flaw. CPC is working with the original architecture firm to create a new design to fix the issue. All fallen sections have been fullen removed.

# Rounds / New Safety Concerns

- JR -
  - There was fire extinguisher training held today for multiple departments, familiarizing participants on safe usage and procedures.
  - A Stryker evacuation chair training was held recently. If your department has a chair and wants training specifically for your group and building, contact JR.
  - Wildfire season is still ongoing. Remember safety procedures for these incidents to take the annual training.
  - VSC is now open both for current occupants and PSU ID holders. The bridge between SRTC and VSC is not currently accessible due to improvements being made, including the area underneath the bridge. Be mindful of equipment and closures around the area.
  - The Art and Design building site on the Shattuck Hall parking lot has been fenced off and construction will be breaking ground in the next few weeks. There will be 4 floors in a U shape with a courtyard, and JR can share renderings at a later date.
    - Some departments will be moved out of FMH, Shattuck, and UCB. PSU will be ending contracts with the UCB space, with SHAC being moved to FMH.
    - CQ Is there more information for the project?
      - JR There will be some temporary traffic disruptions, including the loss of a street lane, the moving of a bike lane, and loss of some parking areas.

- PSU was cited by DEQ for underground storage tank issues several months ago. All issues have since been resolved and a more robust inspection process is in place.
- Many other smaller construction projects are occurring around campus. Make sure you're signed up for building impact notices as there may be disruptions to your space.

- CQ to JR Is there AED training?
  - JR Yes, but it's an outside service that would require payment from individuals or departments. It is not a job requirement to have this training.
- ES Will likely be stepping down soon and is locating a replacement for CUPA.
- JH Remember the construction work on 4th Avenue. Today through September 25th are expected to be the impacted dates. The street is down to 1 lane, and there will be flaggers and equipment in the area. Watch out for traffic issues, and consider alternative routes.
- MO The School of Business is improving event plans for fire safety with EHS. There are an increased number of requests to hold events in the atrium and the department wants to ensure safe practices are followed.
- CQ Remember to spread awareness of CSC membership if anyone would like to join.
