Announcements

- There was an incident in Cramer Hall in regards to asbestos exposure to employees where a contractor was doing work. EHS is working
 on an incident analysis and investigation. OR-OSHA was satisfied with EHS' response and asbestos training.
 - An OR-OSHA complaint was also made related to employee's lack of knowledge of asbestos hazards, and inspection was recently conducted. OR-OSHA and EHS investigations will be finished soon.
 - CQ Do FPM employees have access to asbestos safety training?
 - EH Yes, employees have annual Asbestos Awareness Training, which includes asbestos identification, processes for reporting, health hazards, and more. Other employees go through Operations and Maintenance training, which includes more thorough training and in-person instruction as needed.
- Safety Break 2025 will now most likely be happening on May 21st to avoid conflict with the Campus Beautification event on May 14th. A

- 3/6/25, SHAC, Nurse sprained/strained left foot. They were going up on their toes to reach something on a top shelf for the autoclave in one of the cupboards and felt a sharp pain across the top of foot and then it was hard to step on the foot without pain for about 2 hours.
 - EH followed up to see if items were stored too high. They were at an appropriate level, and employee did not need to reach. This
 injury may have been the result of foot strain from standing all day without an anti fatigue mat.



- 3/3/25, SHAC, Nurse sprained/strained neck. Was moving x-ray tube up with neck slightly tipped back and felt / heard spine make a pop/crack/noise. Neck with some soreness an hour later.
 - EH followed up and saw gallon water jugs that needed to be moved under the autoclave. Employee also prefers to stand while working, but not have an anti fatigue mat. EH to investigate more.
- 3/24/25, Campus Rec, Fitness admin lacerated right hand. They were demonstrating how the low pulley on new cable column machine had a poor design and accidentally bumped finger into the metal plate near the pulley, causing a laceration on right middle finger.
 - There was a burr on the unfinished metal. This has since been corrected.
