Insulated, waterproof)	Gloves to address a variety of hazards are stocked in Stores and provided as needed. Specialized gloves for non-routine hazards will be provided with supervisor approval. Working around loud equipment or construction activities	Hearing Protection	Hearing protection including ear plugs and ear muffs are stocked in Stores and provided as needed. Specialized hearing protection (such as different sizes or styles) will be provided with supervisor approval.	29CFR 1910.95(a-b)
Working at construction sites, around open ceilings, or in other areas with overhead hazards	Hard Hats	Hard hats are stocked in Stores and provided as needed.	OAR 437-002-0134(1)(a)(A) OAR 437-002-0134(9)(a)
<ul> <li>Working on construction sites</li> <li>Working with heavy equipment</li> <li>Puncture hazards such as metal and nails</li> <li>Chemicals and hazardous materials</li> </ul>	Sturdy Shoes/Boots	Sturdy, closed-toe shoes are a minimum requirement for on-the-job safety and are provided by the employee. Moving heave equipment, furniture, or drums that pose toe crushing or cutting hazards	Steel Toe Boots or Equivalent	PSU provides up to \$150 once a year for purchase of steel toe shoes or boots for employees whose work duties routinely expose them to toe crushing or cutting hazards as determined by the supervisor. Toe guards will be provided for employees who require toe protection on a one-time or infrequent basis.	OAR 437-002-0134(1)(a)(A) OAR 437-002-0134(4)(b)
Asbestos     Chemicals	Respirators	Respirators and some cartridges are stocked in Stores and provided a needed. Additional cartridges will be provided as needed. Those required to wear respirators must be cleared by EHS, fit-tested, and assigned a specific respirator.	29CFR 1910.134(a)(2) 29CFR 1910.134(c)(2)(i)
Work around dust, sweepers, minor nuisance dust	Nuisance Dust Masks	Dust masks are stocked in Stores and provided as needed. Use is optional. Those required to wear respirators based on the hazards of their work duties, see "Respirators," above.	29CFR 1910.134(c)(2)(i)
