## SUMMARY

This report provides population estimates for Oregon, its counties, and cities for the years 1980 through 1995. As mandated by Oregon law (ORS 190.510 to 190.610), the Center for Population Research and Census at Portland State University, acting on behalf of the State Board of Higher Education, annually estimates the July 1 population for each county and incorporated city in Oregon. These population estimates are used in the allocation of certain state tax revenues to cities and counties.

Population figures presented in this report represent all the people who usually reside in the area designated. This includes people living in correctional institutions, nursing homes, and college dormitories. College students are considered residents of the place where they live while attending college. Seasonal populations, such as those living in summer homes, are considered residents of the place they consider their usual residence.

The eight tables and five figures in this report show current and historical population data for Oregon. The following three pages briefly describe some of the population trends in Oregon.

Oregon's estimated July 1, 1995 population is 3,132,000 which represents about 1.2% of the United States' population of 262,755,000. Oregon's population increased 289,679 people (10.2%) in the 63 months since the last U.S. Decennial Census (April 1, 1990). This rate of increase is almost double that of the United States (5.6%) during this time. For eight consecutive years, Oregon has grown at a much faster rate than the national average.

Oregon has gained about 289,700 people since April 1, 1990 owing to natural increase (births minus deaths) and net migration (people moving to Oregon minus people leaving Oregon). Natural increase has accounted for about 83,900 new Oregonians and there has been a net in-migration of about 205,800 people in the 1990's.

Figure 1 shows Oregon's net migration from 1981 to 1995. It is evident from this graph that migration can vary from year to year. For example, Oregon experienced a net migration of -30,250 people from 1985 to 1986 whereas between 1986 and 1987 there was a net migration of +13,600 people. The substantial net out-migration occurring in 1982, 1983, and 1986 is reflective of the recession in Oregon in the early 1980's. Conversely, in each year from 1988 to 1995, Oregon had net in-migration of more than 30,000 people. The substantial migration into and out of Oregon since 1985 may have changed the composition of Oregon's population. It is estimated that about 950,000 people or 30% of all Oregon residents in 1995 did not live in Oregon ten years earlier.

Figure 2 shows a map of Oregon's July 1, 1995 county population estimates. What is particularly striking about this figure is that the six most highly populated counties are located on what may be termed the I-5 corridor. These counties (Multnomah, Washington, Clackamas, Marion, Lane, and Jackson) contain 2,029,400 people or 65% of the state's 1995 population. Another example of the uneven population distribution in Oregon is that although half of Oregon's

36 counties are east of the Cascade Range, these counties contain only 406,800 people or 13% of the state's population. The percentage of Oregon's population that is east of the Cascade Range has remained constant over time; in 1980 it was 13%. Additionally, the 12 least populated counties are east of the Cascade Range.

Population estimates for 1995 show that Multnomah County (626,500) continues to have substantially more people than any other Oregon county (Table 6). Washington County is the second most populous county (370,000). Clackamas County which surpassed Lane County as the third most populous county in 1992 now has 6,700 more people than Lane County (308,600 to 301,900). At the other end of the spectrum, three counties have fewer than 2,000 people: Wheeler (1,550), Gilliam (1,750), and Sherman (1,900).

Table 6 shows that 34 of Oregon's 36 counties gained population from 1990 to 1995. The three Portland Area counties of Washington (+58,446), Multnomah (+42,613), and Clackamas (+29,750) each gained more than 20,000 people during this time. These three counties have gained 130,809 people in the 1990's which represents 45% of Oregon's population increase during this time. Four other counties gained more than 10,000 people: Marion (+29,517), Deschutes (+19,142), Lane (+18,988), and Jackson (+18,011). Sherman (-18) and Harney (-10) are the only counties to lose population during the 1990's.

Figure 3 shows the percent change in population from 1990 to 1995. The fastest growing counties are not located in any one area of the state. For example, Deschutes (25.5%) and Jefferson (17.7%), the fastest and third fastest growing counties, are in Central Oregon; Washington (18.8%) and Yamhill (13.8%) are in the Portland Metropolitan Area; Curry (14.9%) and Josephine (13.5%) are in the South West and border California; and Morrow (14.1%) borders Washington in the North Central part of the state.

Figure 5 shows a graph of Oregon's 1995 population by age and gender. The number of people in each age group decreases (with increasing age) from about 230,000 ages 0-4 to about 200,000 ages 25-29; substantial increases are found in the next three age groups with the greatest number of Oregonians between the ages 40-44 (264,000). The population in subsequent age groups decreases substantially with increasing age through the age group 60-64. The number of Oregonians ages 60-64 is less than one-half the number ages 40-44 (113,000 vs. 264,000). The population pattern by gender shows that there are slightly more males than females under age 30; little difference exists by gender among those ages 30-59. Beyond age 59 there are more females than males, with the differential increasing with age. Oregon has almost twice as many females ages 80 and older than males (69,200 vs. 38,200).

Approximately 430,000 Oregonians are ages 65 and older (Table 8); this represents 13.7% of Oregon's population, a figure that is slightly higher than the national average of 12.7%. In the 1980's, Oregon's elderly population (those ages 65 and older) grew at a substantially faster rate than the total state population (28.5% to 7.9%). This pattern has changed in the 1990's with the elderly population increasing at a rate similar to the total state population (10.3% to 10.2%) since April 1, 1990. Approximately one-half of the increase in the elderly population in the 1990's is due to the aging of Oregon's population and one-half is due to net in-migration of people ages 65 and older.

Figure 4 shows a map of the percentage of elderly by county. Seven counties have an elderly population representing at least 20% of their total population: Curry (25.5%), Wheeler (21.5%), Tillamook (21.2%), Lincoln (20.9%), Sherman (20.8%), Gilliam (20.2%), and Josephine (20.0%). These counties are located in different areas of the state with two in the North West bordering the Pacific Ocean, two in the South West on the California border, and three in the North Central part of the state, east of the Cascade Range. Conversely, two counties have less than 11% of their population ages 65 and older: Benton (10.1%) and Washington (10.1%). Clackamas (11.9%) and Multnomah (12.4%) also have a relatively low proportion of elderly and thus the three most populous counties (all of which are in the Portland Area) have a substantially lower proportion of elderly than the state average. The population dynamics of Curry and Josephine Counties are unique in that not only have these counties experienced rapid population growth in the 1990's, but they also have a large proportion of elderly. Other counties with a substantial population increase since 1990 have a relatively small proportion of elderly.

Table 4 categorizes Oregon cities by population size. Portland is Oregon's most populous city and its estimated population of 497,600 is about four times the second and third most populous cities: Eugene (121,905) and Salem (118,355). The City of Portland has more people than any Oregon county with the exception of Multnomah. It is quite clear from Table 4 that most of the cities in Oregon have relatively few people. Approximately one-half of Oregon's 240 incorporated cities have a population under 1,450, and 52 cities have fewer than 500 residents. Conversely, only 16% of the cities have a population greater than 10,000.

As in the 1980's, many cities gained new residents because of expanding city boundaries (Table 5). Since April 1, 1990, 93 cities have annexed land containing 60,162 people at the time of annexation. Portland gained 47,225 residents through annexations which is about 78% of the total number of people gained through annexations. Other cities gaining more than 1,000 people through annexations are Albany (+3,870), Bend (+3,316), and Roseburg (+1,190). The vast majority of the annexations involve few people with only 15 of the 93 cities gaining more than 100 people through annexations.

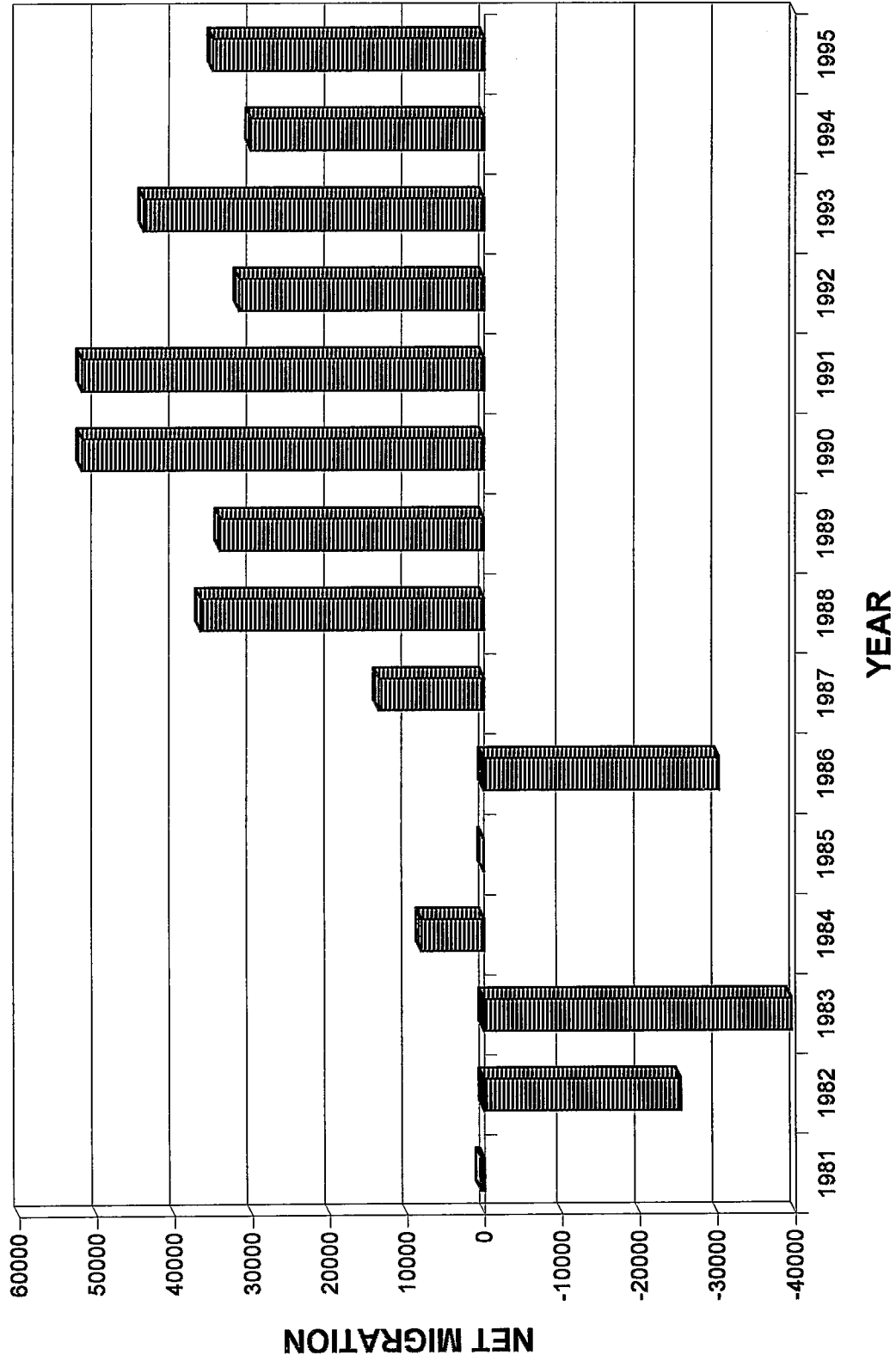

## OREGON NET MIGRATION:

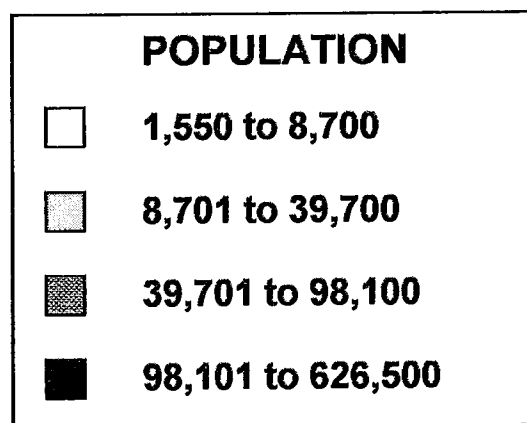
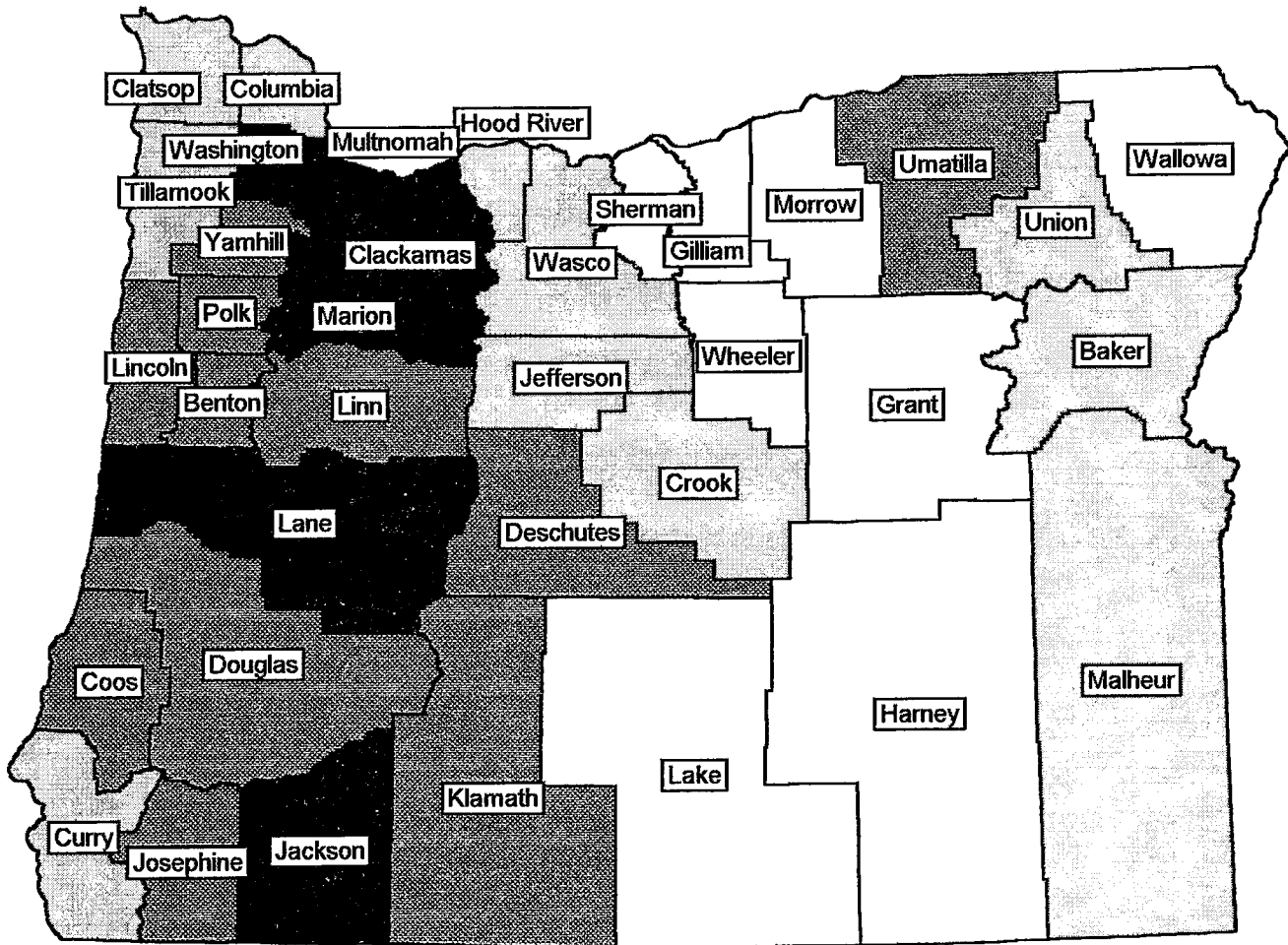
July 1, 1981 to July 1, 1995

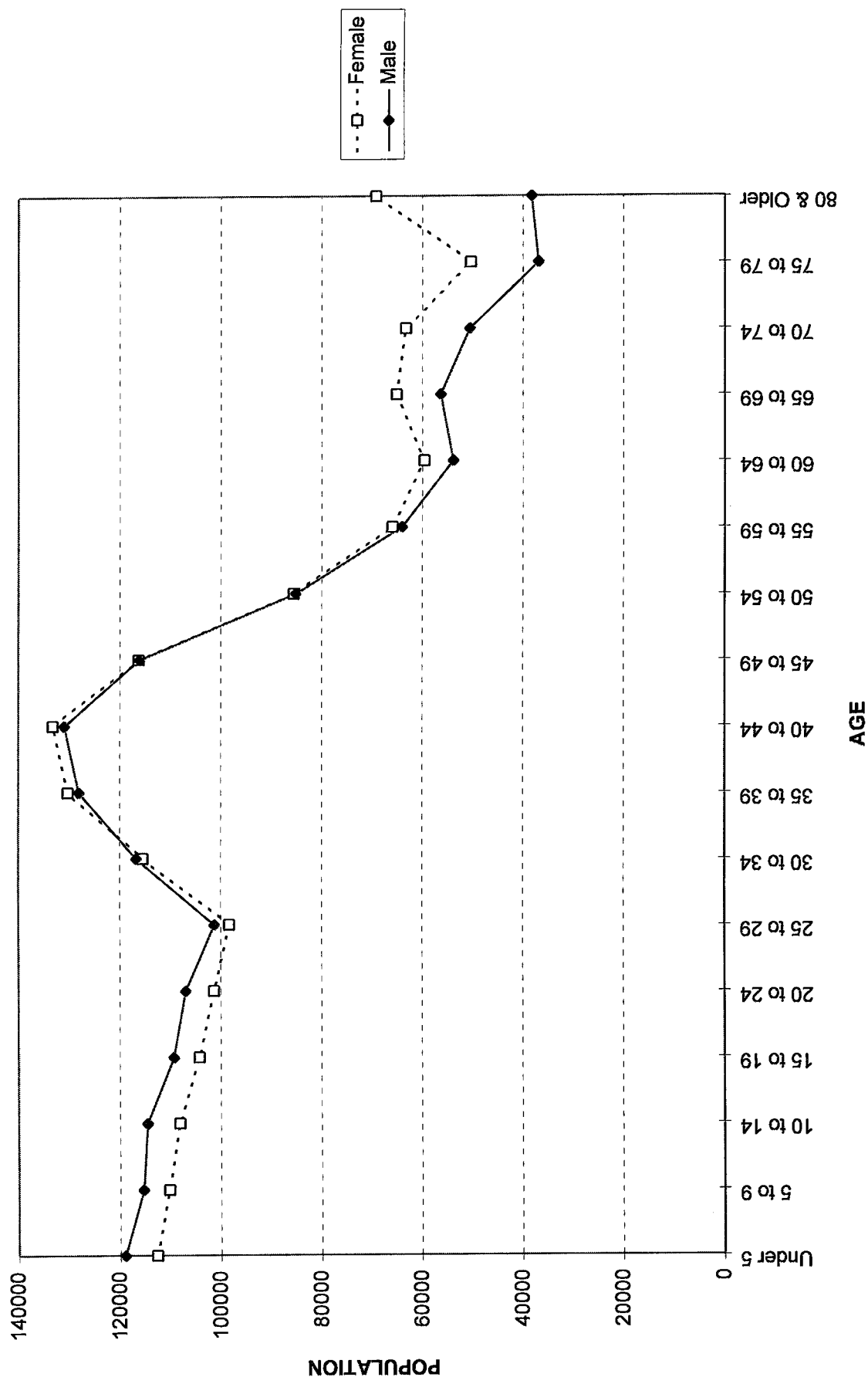
## JULY 1, 1995 POPULATION ESTIMATES
