

B-1/B-2 & Visa Waiver International Visitor Declaration Form

Purpose:

This form is used to pay international visitors in business or tourist status (B-1, B-2, WB, WT) honoraria and/or reimbursement for incidental expenses.

Eligibility for Payments:

International visitors in a business or tourist status (B-1, B-2, WB or WT) are eligible to be paid honoraria and/or reimbursed for reasonable expenses if the following conditions are met:

1. The visitor is performing an academic activity for the benefit of PSU.
2. The activity is no more than nine (9) days in duration.
3. The individual paid the honorarium or reimbursement has not accepted similar payments from more than five (5) institutions in the U.S. in the previous six (6) month period.
