We are guided by our values and wellbeing, equity, community and student success goals. The vast majority of the employees you see are students – some employed in their first job – and we focus on professional development and connection to academics.

In order to facilitate a welcoming and inclusive environment for all – we ask for your respect and patience and we want to remind you of the following:

- **Membership is a resource that may be revoked for cause at the discretion of Campus Recreation in coordination with other departments of Portland State University (such as Conduct or HR) as necessary.**
- **Actions that will result in loss of access include (but are not limited to): THEFT, FIGHTING, HARRASSMENT and DISCRIMINATION.**
- Members agree that failure to obey Campus Rec policies can result in staff asking them to leave immediately. Appeals to these decisions are handled by administration after the fact.
- All Members are required to sign and agree to the waiver and to have to have a photo on file to ensure proper identification.
- Please do not leave belongings unattended in the building. Campus Recreation is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- All memberships include facility closures for holidays, CREC events, maintenance, renovation, staff training, weather etc. Rates are not pro-rated nor discounted due to closures. The Rec Center always closes and delays opening when the university does so due to inclement weather.
